CITATION:

Flight Sergeant MAYO joined No. 13 Squadron on 19 February 1945, and since that date has been N.C.O. in charge of "B" Flight, which appointment he has carried competently and efficiently.

On the afternoon of 8th August, 1945, Flight Sergeant MAYO was testing an electrically-driven fuel transfer pump of Aircraft A.59-73, when the petrol ignited and the aircraft commenced to burn. With complete disregard for his own safety, he removed the burning petrol and enabled the fire in the aircraft to be extinguished. Flight Sergeant MAYO sustained severe burns, but his prompt action undoubtedly saved the aircraft from destruction.
